

## Admission Arrangements

For September 2017 Intake:

The Willink School is a local authority maintained school and it is West Berkshire LA that manages admissions. Parents should contact the LA to find out the details of admission arrangements.

In line with Government Policy on open enrolment, the school shall meet parental preference wherever possible. Looked After Children and those with an Education, Health & Care Plan (EHCP) or statement of Special Educational Needs (SEND) have first priority. Applicants living in the designated areas of the following feeder schools will be given priority:

- Aldermaston C of E Primary (South of Railway Line)
- Burghfield St. Mary's C of E Primary
- Garland Junior, Burghfield Common
- St. Mary's Junior, Mortimer
- Sulhamstead and Ufton Nervet C of E Aided Primary

After allocating places to students within the catchment area any remaining places will be allocated to siblings of existing students, out of catchment. Any further remaining places will be prioritised by distance from the school to a home address.

Each year we accept students from outside our catchment area whose application selects The Willink as their first choice school. In September 2016 we accepted students from the 34 non-feeder primary schools listed below. There will be up to 40 places available in September 2017 for children living outside the school's catchment area.
